

## Modification the Head light Blues

Have you ever wonder why some people have ideas of installing Halogen headlights in older Chevelles. I did. The problem I had was the electrical system in my 69 Chevelle. It started to intermit after a while. I did not know that Halogen headlights produce more wattage then the standard GM headlights. The result is more current flow in the fuse panel. There is only one main feed going into the connector in the fuse panel. The result was the connector started to overheat and oxidize to the point of meltdown. The plastic in the fuse panel around the connector was melting. With in time, my electrical system would go out.

I had to rectify the intermittent problem. I had to install 30 amp automotive relays for the low beam and high beam. Before you decide to install high wattage Halogen headlights, make sure the fuse panel is in good shape. The older the Chevelle, the worst it can get.
